

Use this form to help you in the measuring /quoting process. When complete, group the windows that have the same specs and enter into the quote page on windowslip.com.

Window # - Number in order, 1, 2, 3 and so forth.

Room - Identify what room the window is installed in; describe as living room, dining room, kitchen, bedroom, office, etc

Floor - Enter the number of the floor the window is installed on; describe as first, second, third, basement, etc

Window Type - Indicate whether single or double hung, casement, picture window or French casement

Which Operate - Indicate the direction the window opens from; Sash 1, Sash 2, Both, or None

Sash Daylight Size - Measure the top and bottom sash daylight size and input those numbers below. For single sash windows, use sash 1. For double hung windows and French casements, use both sash 1 and sash 2 input areas. Watch our measurement video for how to daylight size.

Glass Options - Enter the type of glass you would like the slip to be built with; Options are: Clear, Low-E, Obscure and Tinted
